Action Items Code of Conduct - Dr. Stirn reviewed the code of conduct with the board. The code will be adopted by the Board.

Weighted Grades – Principal Haug presented new information related to weighing grades this year. He explained that while the best interest of students was the reason to weigh honors classes, some student's grades would be hurt by just implementing weighted grades at this time. Grades could be changed manually but there is a risk for error handling grades that way. Principal Haug recommended that weighted honors classes begin at the start of the 2011/2012 school year. By delaying the start of weighted honors classes, time is given to take a closer look at the content and rigor of honors classes ensuring students will be challenged. Several students from CHS attended the meeting in favor of delaying the honors weighted grades until the start of the 11/12 school year. Principal Haug's recommendation of is to delay the start of weighted honors classes until the beginning of the 11/12 school year.
