

H.B.T. Playground Rules

1. Everyone goes outside unless you have a note from home.
2. Bathrooms and water fountains are to be used BEFORE going outside. The doors will be locked.
3. The building may only be reentered if there is an emergency. Please report all emergencies or injuries to the supervisor IMMEDIATELY!
4. Please dress for the weather. You must wear boots and snowpants when there is snow on the ground to play on the equipment. Otherwise, you need to stay on the blacktop.
5. When snow is piled from plowing the blacktop, please DO NOT PLAY ON THE MOUNDED SNOW or throw SNOW/ICE BALLS at any time.
6. When the play period ends, please line up quickly and quietly to reenter the building. The sidewalk from the school doors to the gym is a QUIET ZONE. NO TALKING OR BALL BOUNCING ALLOWED! This is disruptive to the classrooms near the playground.
7. Please play the appropriate games in the designated areas.
8. Please wait for your turn when using playground equipment.
9. Don't go beyond the red line between the cafeteria and the soccer field.
10. Use the slides properly. Go **DOWN** (not UP!) them in a seated position one person at a time. Do not climb on top of the tunnel slide.
11. Use the swings appropriately. Swing back and forth. Don't twist, jump, or swing sideways.
12. Use the monkey bars properly. Do NOT sit on top of them.
13. Use the glider properly. Do NOT walk under the glide when in use. Never "whip" the glide or glide upside down.
14. At NO TIME is fighting, or "pretend" fighting, allowed.
15. Please use the blacktop area properly. Basketball and 4 square are the only ball games that should be played on the blacktop. No wall ball! Soccer should be played on the soccer field and football should be played in the grass.
16. No tackle football or other contact activities (like karate or wrestling).
17. Please keep noise to a reasonable level as classes are in session. The area near the classroom windows is a QUIET ZONE.
18. Cheerleading is appropriate, but no stunting or putting others "up in mounds." Keep your hands or feet on the ground.
19. Please do not go into the cornfield. Stop at the edge of the grass.
20. **The supervisors are in charge at all times and are to be obeyed.**
